- Identified ten (10) barriers in the Current Response to efficient functioning of the system:
 - 1. No CIT Team.
 - 2. No involuntary drop off/receiving center.
 - 3. No options for Alcohol & Drug facility other than jail.
 - 4. Chattanooga Police Department not authorized to transport.
 - 5. No post jail follow-up.
 - 6. Insufficient number of certified mental health staff to issue certificate of need.
 - 7. Unnecessary medical clearance required in some situations.
 - 8. Extended wait time at Erlanger.
 - 9. Excessive wait time for mental health Crisis Response Team.
 - 10. Waiting on 2nd Prescreened Backup to come to the scene.
